## Background

In recent decades, new agricultural business models have emerged in a number of transition, emerging and developed economies. The main characteristics of these business models include a very large size of operations that sometimes reaches more than one hundred thousand hectares of farmland, integration of multiple stages of production and processing, and entry of the investors that often have no background in primary agriculture.

The conference's main geographical focus is on the transition countries of Central and Eastern Europe, Central and East Asia and developed and emerging economies in Western Europe, America and Australia.

The IAMO Forum 2018 is jointly organized by the Department of Structural Development of Farms and Rural Areas of IAMO, DLG e.V. and the Association Ukrainian Agribusiness Club (UCAB).

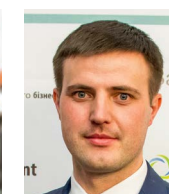
